1. Overview

This Privacy Notice describes the collection, use, and disclosure of information about you in connection with your use of the Propstore website ("**Site**") or our services provided directly to you ("**Services**").

Propstore collects Personal Information to facilitate your use of our Site and Services. We have a legitimate interest in the collection and disclosure of this information in certain circumstances.

3. How We Use the Information We Collect

The Personal Information we collect, and the practices described above, are undertaken to provide you with the best experience possible, protect you from risks related to improper use and fraud, and help us maintain and improve Propstore offerings. We may use your Personal Information to:

- **Provide You with Propstore Services.** Propstore uses your Personal Information to provide you with its Services and Site pursuant to its Terms of Use for the Site and this Privacy Notice.
- **Comply with Legal and Regulatory Requirements.** Propstore processes your Personal Information as required by applicable laws and regulations.

- **Protect the Security and Integrity of Our Site and Services.** Propstore uses your Personal Information to further our security practices related to Personal Information.
- **Optimize and Enhance Our Services, and statistical analysis.** Propstore uses your Personal Information to understand how our Services are being used to help us improve our Services and manage our business.
- **Customer and Consignor Feedback Surveys.** Propstore may contact you via email to ask you to complete surveys and feedback forms. We do this to improve our customer and consignor services and the products we offer. You are under no obligation to respond to such requests.
- **Market Our Services to You.** Propstore may contact you with information about our Services. We will only do so with your permission, which can be revoked at any time.
- **Other Business Purposes.** Propstore may use your information for additional purposes if that purpose is disclosed to you before we collect the information or if we obtain your consent. A legitimate interest is when we have a business or commercial reason to use your personal data, so long as this is not overridden by your own rights and interests. If under UK/EU data protection laws we rely on 'legitimate interests' to process your personal data, we will undertake appropriate assessments as required by applicable laws to fully consider and protect your privacy rights.

We may use the Personal Information we collect or receive through the Site and Services (alone or in combination with other data we source) for the purposes and on the legal bases identified below:

- To perform our contract with you for use of the Site and Services or, where we have not entered into a contract with you, in accordance with our legitimate interests to operate and administer our Site and Services.
- To enforce compliance with our contractual obligations and applicable law, and to protect your rights and safety in reliance on our legitimate interest to protect against misuse or abuse of our Site and Services and to pursue available remedies. This includes, in some cases, disclosing the identity of our consignors/buyers to allow the relevant party to enforce a contractual or legal right, or bring a claim, against the other party. This takes place in limited circumstances where following an auction there is a product issue, failure to make payment in full, or suspected fraud.
- To meet legal requirements, including complying with court orders, valid discovery requests, valid subpoenas, and other appropriate legal mechanisms.
- To provide information to representatives and advisors, including attorneys and accountants, to help us comply with legal, accounting, or security requirements in reliance on our legitimate interests.
- To prosecute and defend a court, arbitration, or similar legal proceeding.
- To respond to lawful requests by public authorities, including to meet national security or law enforcement requirements.
- To provide, support, and improve the Site and Services to perform our contract with you for the use of the Site and Services or, where we have not entered into a contract with you, in reliance on our legitimate interests in administering and improving the Site and Services and providing certain features. When we share your Personal Information with third parties, we take steps to protect your information in a manner that is consistent with our obligations under applicable privacy laws.

7. Retention of Data

We retain Personal Information where we have an ongoing legitimate business or legal need to do so. Our retention periods will vary depending on the type of data involved, but, generally, we refer to these criteria in order to determine retention period:

- Whether we have a legal or contractual need to retain the data;
- Whether the data is necessary to provide our Site and Services; and
- Whether our consumers would reasonably expect that we would retain the data until they remove it or until their accounts are closed or terminated.

We will generally retain your Personal Information in line with our internal retention policies and will not keep such information for longer than necessary, in accordance with applicable data protection laws. When you use our Services we will generally retain that Personal Information for 6 years, in accordance with statutory limitation periods.

When we have no ongoing legitimate business need to process your Personal Information, we will either delete or anonymize it or, if this is not possible (for example, because your Personal Information has been stored in backup archives), then we will securely store your Personal Information and cease any further processing until deletion is possible.

8. Security

Verification	In order to protect your Personal Information from unauthorized access or deletion, we may require you to verify your account credentials before you can submit a rights request. Propstore is legally obligated to verify your identity when you submit a request. We may request additional information from you to verify your identity. If you submit a request to delete your Personal Information, you will also be required to confirm the deletion request by email. If we are subsequently unable to confirm your identity, we may refuse your rights request.
Use of Authorized Agents	You may use an authorized agent to submit a rights request.
