E.T. The Extra-Terrestrial (1982)

Mary Taylor's (Dee Wallace) screen-matched leopard-print dress from Steven Spielberg's E.T. the Extra-Terrestrial. On Halloween, working single mother Mary wore her leopard-print dress as part of her cat-woman costume. After she took a picture of Elliot (Henry Thomas) and Michael (Robert MacNaughton) with the disguised E.T., she escorted them outside to see them off for trick-or-treating, who, unbeknownst to her, were off to help E.T. "phone home" in the forest. This dress screen-matches to the scenes outside the house at dusk based on the unique patterning on the dress in relation to its construction.

After a massively successful theatrical run, E.T. went on to become the highest-grossing motion picture of all time in 1983 and to sell more than 15 million E.T. dolls in its first year of release. Inspiring more than \$1 billion in merchandising sales, the character is today known worldwide as one of the most beloved in all of science-fiction cinema, and is widely considered Rambaldi's signature creation. E.T. the Extra-Terrestrial has won four Academy Awards®, two Golden Globe Awards®, and four Grammy Awards® since its release. It consistently ranks in the American Film Institute's Top 100 films, and was listed by Time as one of the best 100 films ever made.
