Tom Chantrell Archive: UK Quad (Pre-Oscar Awards Style) - Rolled, 1977

STAR WARS: A NEW HOPE (1977)

From the personal archive of the artist Tom Chantrell comes this beautiful UK Quad "Non-Oscars®" poster for "Star Wars" (1977). The "Non-Oscars" version of this poster was used in the early weeks of the UK release and was subsequently replaced with the "Oscars®" version. The "Non-Oscars" version is by far the scarcer of the two Quads, with Chantrell's "Star Wars" poster imagery achieving iconic status. Although he previewed the film and was given set photographs stills, Chantrell took photos of his wife in the back garden posing as Princess Leia that he used for reference in the creation of his poster composition. Never displayed or used and offered unrestored, this example remains in rare unfolded condition with deep, rich colour tones and is accompanied by a letter of authenticity from the Chantrell Collection signed by the Archive's curator Mike Bloomfield and Tom's Wife Shirley.



Untrimmed UK "Gone with the Wind" Style A Quad

STAR WARS: THE EMPIRE STRIKES BACK (1980)

An untrimmed UK "Gone with the Wind" Style A Quad from the promotion of Irvin Kershner's Star Wars: The Empire Strikes Back. Considered to be one of the rarest and most beautiful of all the Star Wars saga posters, this British UK Quad for the release of the film in 1980 features artwork by Roger Kastel. It is often affectionately referred to as the "Gone with the Wind" style, due to its similarities to the classic 1939 movie poster. After a very limited initial release, many of these posters were trimmed for usage on the London Underground. However, this is an untrimmed poster, considered to be the 'Holy Grail' of Star Wars posters by collectors, with a 10/10 rarity rating from writer Stephen Sansweet in his Star Wars Poster Book.

STAR WARS: THE EMPIRE STRIKES BACK (1980)

A first for Propstore and an exceptionally rare British Royal Charity World Premiere poster designed by Eddie Paul of FEREF with finished artwork by Ralph McOuarrie that features a version of McOuarrie's Vader in Flames artwork. The Charity World Premiere took place in London on the 20th May 1980 (as stated on the poster). This date was very close to the original British Empire Day, which was first held in 1902, on Oueen Victoria's birthday the 24th May, and became an annual event from 1916 until it changed in 1958. The 20th Century Fox marketing department took full advantage of the film's release date as an army of Stormtroopers - in Jeeps and on foot - took to the streets of London, holding placards of this poster to build up the crowd's already heightened excitement for the much-anticipated sequel. Presented unrestored in original flat. unfolded condition this example displays to excellent effect and is one of the rarest posters and pieces of marketing material known to exist for The Empire Strikes Back and the series.




An Advance UK Ouad film poster featuring Drew Struzan's artwork for the third movie in Lucas' original Star Wars trilogy Return of the Jedi (1983). Although the first examples printed (in the USA) featuring Struzan's artwork were titled 'Revenge of the Jedi'. the correct title for the movie was used in the UK One of Struzan's best designs, the Ouad shows the duelling silhouettes of Luke and Darth Vader with their lightsabers crossed against a dramatic deep red background with an image of Vader's mask next to the title text box. Although primarily for cinema use, a very small number were printed with different text to cross-promote the movie with different retailers. There was a TOYS AVAILABLE HERE. PARKER VIDEO GAMES and as offered here a READ-ALONG STORYBOOK from W.E.A. Records. which is generally considered the rarest of these alternative printings.






INDIANA JONES TRILOGY (1981-89)





US Lenticular One-Sheet Printer's Proof, 2004
HARRY POTTER AND THE PRISONER OF AZKABAN (2004)

Harry Potter's heroic godfather, Sirius Black (Gary Oldman), is depicted on this incredibly rare (possibly a one-off) concept design One-Sheet prototype that Warner Bros never issued. In a brilliant marketing ploy, Warner's created this poster to mimic the "Wanted" posters used in the movie itself. What was exciting about those was that you could see Sirius laughing with insanity on the poster. Warners tried duplicating a motion effect here using the lenticular printing process. As one moves back and forth before this poster, the image of Black begins to disappear and then reappears. After creating only six of these full-size prototypes at a facility in Michigan, Warner's decided that it was too expensive to put them into full production. so the project was dropped. The example being offered has alternative lettering to the six that are known, and we believe this to be an early design (it is dated 22nd August 2003) that. although produced (note the printer's colour bars running vertically down the right side of the image) never went into full production. It should be noted, and to avoid confusion, that this is not the small-sized lenticular produced in multiple numbers for the lobby standees. If you're a Harry Potter fan and collector, then this is the poster for you and probably the rarest of any lenticular poster produced.







A first release 1978 British 30-sheet poster for Deer Hunter, Michael Cimino's multi Academy-Award® winning Vietnam war drama. This enormous poster displays Fred Atkins' controversial advertising campaign depicting Robert DeNiro with the "Russian roulette" pistol to his head (a significant scene in the film). Marketing material featuring this imagery was withdrawn from circulation within days after its initial appearance as it was considered too disturbing. It is rare for 30 sheets to be saved as most were destroyed from being pasted to billboards.






75.British Double Crown - Linen-Backed, 1956 **BUS STOP (1956)**

Widely considered to be the best artwork of Marilyn Monroe, Tom Chantrell's beautifully designed British Double-Crown for Bus Stop (1956) perfectly captures the "Blonde Bombshell" at the height of her fame following The Seven Year Itch (1955). In the film, stubborn but naïve rodeo cowboy Beauregard "Bo" Decker (Don Murray) falls in love with café singer Cherie (Monroe), who dreams of travelling to Hollywood to become famous. Thinking he must make her his wife, Bo forces Cherie on a bus back to his hometown of Montana, but things don't quite go according to plan. This role was considered a little less glamorous than Monroe's previous onscreen characters and saw a change in her acting career. It is a captivating and enchanting poster featuring the iconic movie star that rarely comes to market.
